PROPOSAL

This proposal includes:

- **Duplex card** (Custom printing on both sides of the card, color on front, black and white on the back. Color on back is available)

Set up charges for Emergency Service agencies are waived.

A customized form is sent to you for the members to fill out with pertinent information for the ID cards.

Completed initial order is shipped via Federal Express Ground or USPS Priority Mail at no additional cost so the ID cards can be traced. (Shipments made to residential addresses available at an additional charge).

For new members: Individuals fill out the form, sign the bottom of the form with an **fine** sharpie type marker and send it along with a digital picture to us to produce their card.

We only produce cards that the contact individual of the organization authorizes us to produce in writing.

All information is password protected and is never given to anyone, anytime.
